

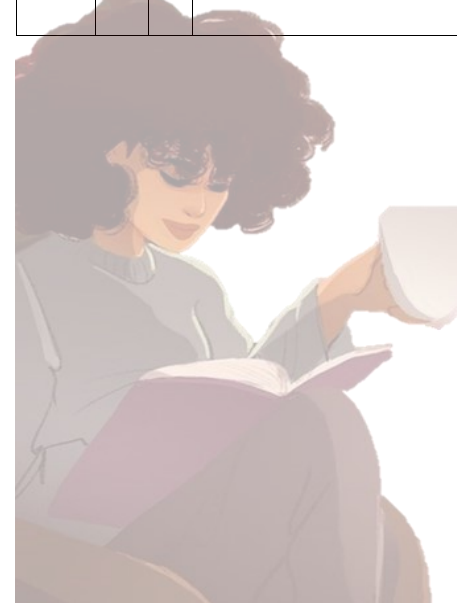
Read Your Bible Pray Everyday
